### NATIONAL VOTERS DAY January 25, 2021


#### ELECTORAL LOGO AND SLOGAN WRITING COMPETITION

#### DEPICTING SCIENCE AND INNOVATION THROUGH CARTOON MAKING










## TECH ENCLAVE March 9, 2021
