








INDUSTRY VISIT-APPMOBI IT SERVICES FEBRUARY 8, 2022








EXPERT TALK ON LOGIC BUILDING FEBRUARY 8, 2022




WEBINAR ON DOMAIN NAME SYSTEM (DNS) FEBRUARY 22, 2022









SESSION ON CYBER SECURITY MARCH 10, 2022






TECHGYANAM MARCH 12, 2022

APPLICATION AREAS OF MACHINE LEARNING MARCH 22, 2022








WEB DEVELOPMENT USING JOOMLA MARCH 25, 2022









FROM RIGHT PORTFOLIO TO RIGHT JOBS FEBRUARY 19, 2022







AI AND ROBOTICS: LATEST TRENDS IN TECHNOLOGIES FEBRUARY 21, 2022







ONLINE GROUP DISCUSSION FEBRUARY 26, 2022




NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY: SCI-FI MOVIE TRIVIA FEBRUARY 28, 2022






COLLAGE MAKING COMPETITION – WORLD WILDLIFE DAY MARCH 3, 2022




CREATIVE EYE MARCH 4, 2022




MULTIMEDIA PRESENTATION ON CLIMATE JUSTICE MARCH 10, 2022






AGNOSTIC CLICK MARCH 15, 2022


THE BOLLYWOOD QUIZ MARCH 15, 2022


FDP ON INTRODUCTION TO VMWARE AND VIRTUALIZATION ESSENTIALS


EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES IN THE PARADIGM OF CLOUD COMPUTING
