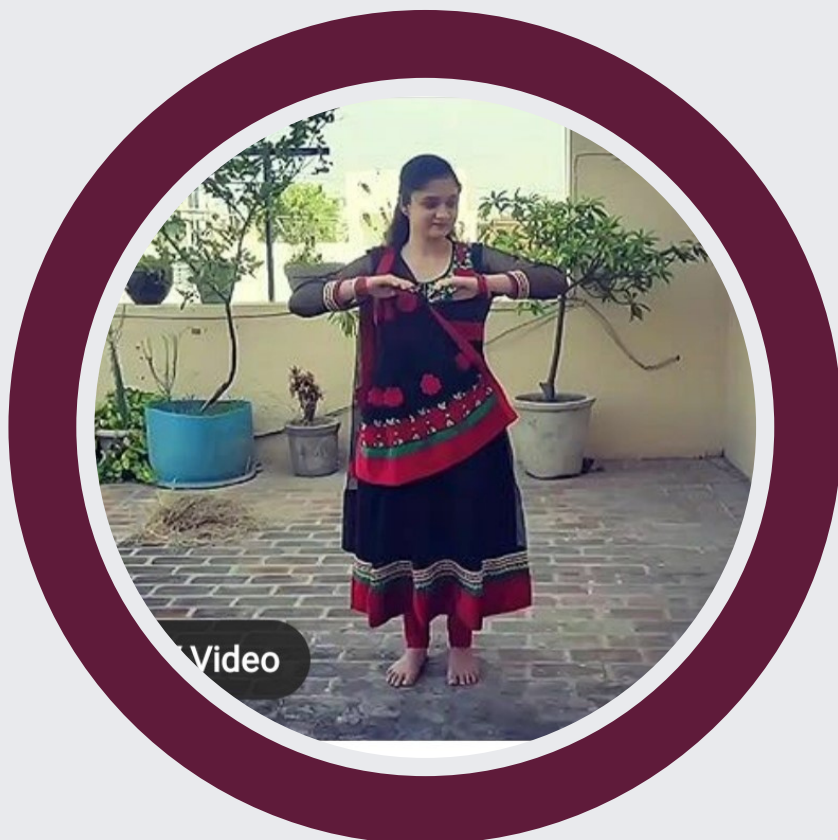

In the round two of the event, the judges gave the challenge to the finalist for another performance.

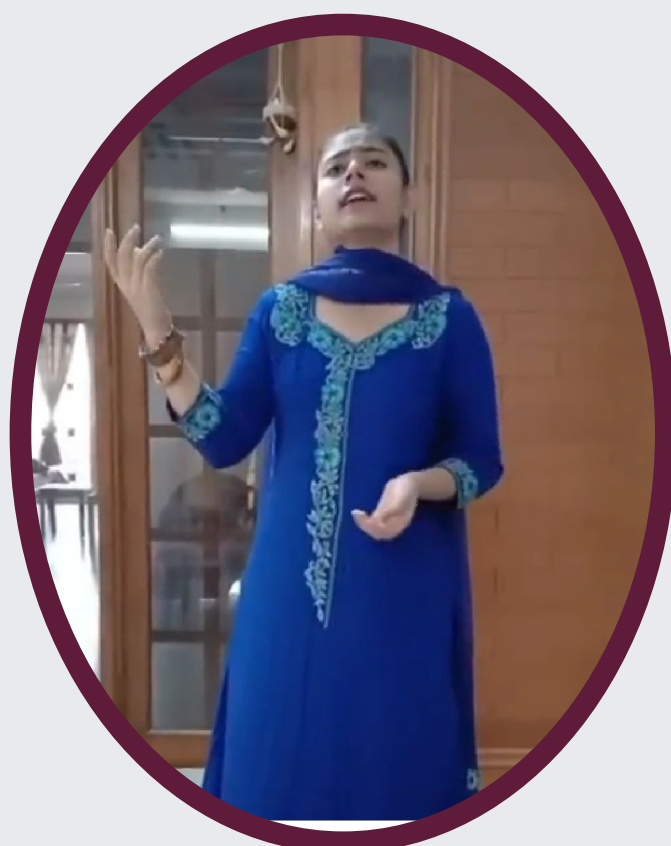
